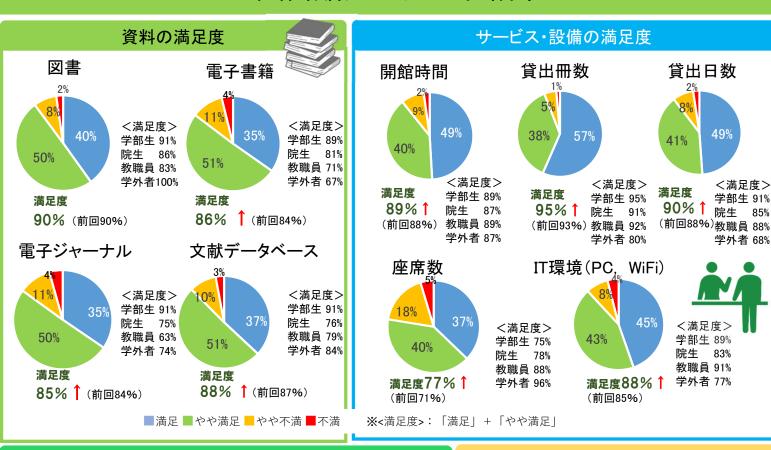

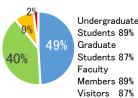

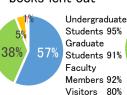

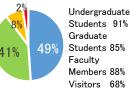

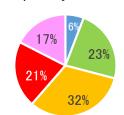

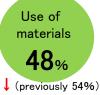

Improved by your Opinions!

I want to charge my computer or smartphone.

I want to use the computer while charging, so please increase the number of outlets.

I want to have a small exchange between library users.

The library was closed due to the COVID-19, so I was in trouble because there was no place for self-study.

Power outlets have been added to each desk. (R3.3)

Please make the air conditioner more effective.
Increase the number of fans.

The air conditioning period and set temperature follow the University's policy. In consideration of abnormal weather, the Library also adjusts the air conditioning by measuring the temperature and humidity. Fans are placed to prevent heat when there is no air conditioning, but they also serve the purpose of air circulation to prevent the spread of infectious diseases. So additional fans have been put.

I want to use a chair that does not put a strain on my lower back even if I sit for a long time.

We replaced some of them with new chairs in the reading room. (R3.3)

I want to join an event to get used books.

Reuse Market was held in both the Main Library and the Annex Library with the cooperation of Tokushima City Library.

The Library has started an Online book club.

I want you to increase the number of books lent out and the book lending days.

The University BCP has been revised to ensure uninterrupted learning opportunities even under student attendance restrictions. Up to BCP level 3, Library use will be permitted while taking measures against infectious

As a result, the Library is now normally open up to BCP level 3. (R3.9)
